

The Kingdom of God and the Whole Gospel

The Bible has much to say about the kingdom of God. Jesus spoke about it often. What did Jesus say and instruct us to say?

Matthew 4:17 (following his temptation by Satan in the desert)

From that time on Jesus began to preach, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is near."

Matthew 4:23, 9:35

Jesus went throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom, and healing every disease and sickness among the people.

Matthew 24:14 (context of the signs of the end of the age)

And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.

Mark 1:15

"The time has come," he said. "The kingdom of God is near. Repent and believe the good news!"

Acts 1:3b (after the resurrection)

He appeared to them over a period of 40 days and spoke about the kingdom of God.

Acts 19:8 (after the resurrection)

Paul entered the synagogue and spoke boldly there for three months, arguing persuasively about the kingdom of God.
