

## Healing Scriptures to Challenge Your Faith and Stand On

### **Psalm 103:2-5**

*Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits--who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion, who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.*

### **Psalm 106:43**

*Many times he delivered them, but they were bent on rebellion and they wasted away in their sin.*

### **Psalm 107:20**

*He sent forth his word, and healed them; he rescued them from the grave.*

### **Exodus 15:26**

*He said, "If you listen carefully to the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in his eyes, if you pay attention to his commands and keep all his decrees, I will not bring on you any of the diseases I brought on the Egyptians, for I am the Lord, who heals you.*

### **Psalm 118:17**

*I will not die but live, and will proclaim what the LORD has done.*

### **Isaiah 53:4-5**

*Surely he took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows, yet we considered him stricken by God, smitten by him, and afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed.*

### **Matthew 8:16-17**

*When evening came, many who were demon-possessed were brought to him and he drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick. This was to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet Isaiah: "He took up our infirmities, and carried our diseases."*

### **1 Peter 2:24**

*He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by his wounds you have been healed.*

### **Romans 8:11**

*And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit, who lives in you.*

### **Proverbs 4:20-22**

*My son, pay attention to what I say; listen closely to my words. Do not let them out of your sight, keep them within your heart; for they are life to those who find them and health to a man's whole body.*

### **2 Kings 20:5b** [to King Hezekiah after he turned his face to the wall and prayed to the LORD]

*I have heard your prayer and seen your tears; I will heal you.*

### **Deuteronomy 7:15a**

*The LORD will keep you free from every disease. He will not inflict on you the horrible diseases you knew in Egypt.*

**Isaiah 58: 6-9a**

*Is not this the kind of fasting I have chosen: to loose the chains of injustice and untie the cords of the yoke, to set the oppressed free and break every yoke? Is it not to share your food with the hungry and to provide the poor wanderer with shelter—when you see the naked, to clothe him, and not to turn away from your own flesh and blood? Then your light will break forth like the dawn, and your healing will quickly appear; then your righteousness will go before you, and the glory of the LORD will be your rear guard. Then you will call, and the LORD will answer; you will cry for help and he will say: Here am I.*

**Deuteronomy 34:7**

*Moses was 120 years old when he died, yet his eyes were not weak nor his strength gone.*

**Exodus 23:25-26**

*Worship the LORD your God, and his blessing will be on your food and water. I will take away sickness from among you, and none will miscarry or be barren in your land. I will give you a full life span.*

**Psalms 147:3**

*He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.*

**Matthew 4:23**

*Jesus went throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom, and healing every disease and sickness among the people.*

**Matthew 8:16**

*When evening came, many who were demon-possessed were brought to him, and he drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick.*

**Matthew 9:35**

*Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness.*

**Matthew 12:15**

*Aware of this, Jesus withdrew from that place. Many followed him, and he healed all their sick.*

**Matthew 14:36**

*And begged him to let the sick just touch the edge of his cloak, and all who touched him were healed.*

**Matthew 15:30**

*Great crowds came to him, bringing the lame, the blind, the crippled, the mute and many others, and laid them at his feet; and he healed them.*

**Mark 6:56**

*And wherever he went—into villages, towns or countryside—they placed the sick in the marketplaces. They begged him to let them touch even the edge of his cloak, and all who touched him were healed.*

**Luke 4:40**

*When the sun was setting the people brought to Jesus all who had various kinds of sickness, and laying his hands on each one, he healed them.*

**Luke 6:18b-19**

*Those troubled by evil spirits were cured, and the people all tried to touch him, because power was coming from him and healing them all.*

**Luke 9:11**

*But the crowds learned about it and followed him. He welcomed them and spoke to them about the kingdom of God, and healed those who needed healing.*

**Acts 5:16**

*Crowds gathered also from the towns around Jerusalem, bringing their sick and those tormented by evil spirits, and all of them were healed.*

**Acts 28:8-9**

*His father was sick in bed, suffering from fever and dysentery. Paul went in to see him and, after prayer, he placed his hands on him and healed him. When this happened, the rest of the sick on the island came and were cured.*

**Mark 16:15, 17-18**

*He said to them "Go into all the world and preach the good news to all creation. And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues; they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well." (KJV signs shall follow)*

**James 5:14-16**

*Is any one of you sick? He should call the elders of the church to pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise him up. If he has sinned, he will be forgiven. Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective.*

**Psalm 112:7-8**

*He will have no fear of bad news; his heart is steadfast, trusting in the LORD. His heart is secure, he will have no fear; in the end he will look in triumph on his foes.*

**Proverbs 3:5-8**

*Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight. Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD and shun evil. This will bring health to your body and nourishment to your bones.*

**Proverbs 17:22**

*A cheerful heart is good medicine, but a crushed spirit dries up the bones.*

**Psalm 23:1**

*The LORD is my shepherd, I shall not be in want.*

**Philippians 4:19**

*And my God will meet all your needs according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus.*

**2 Corinthians 5:7 (KJV)**

*We walk by faith not by sight.*

**Mark 11:24**

*Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.*

**2 Corinthians 1:20a**

*For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ.*

**1 Corinthians 6:19a**

*Do you not know your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God?*

**Isaiah 57:18-19**

*I have seen his ways, but I will heal him; I will guide him and restore comfort to him, creating praise on the lips of the mourners in Israel. Peace, peace, to those far and near, says the LORD. "And I will heal them."*

**Romans 4:17b**

*The God who gives life to the dead and calls things that are not as though they were.*

**Joel 3:10b**

*Let the weakling say, "I am strong!"*

**Nehemiah 8:10b**

*The joy of the LORD is your strength.*

**Habakkuk 3:17-18**

*Though the fig tree does not bud and there are no grapes on the vines, though the olive crop fails, and the fields produce no food, though there are no sheep in the pen and no cattle in the stalls, yet I will rejoice in the Lord. I will be joyful in God my Savior.*

**1 Peter 5:10**

*And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast.*

**1 John 4:4b (KJV)**

*Greater is he that is in you than he that is in the world.*

**Psalms 34:19**

*A righteous man may have many troubles [afflictions KJV], but the LORD delivers him from them all.*

**John 15:7**

*If you remain in me, and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you.*

**2 Chronicles 16:9a**

*For the eyes of the LORD range throughout the earth to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to him.*

**Psalms 18:1**

*I love you, O LORD, my strength.*

**Psalms 28:7-8**

*The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in him, and I am helped. My heart leaps for joy and I will give thanks to him in song. The LORD is the strength of his people, a fortress of salvation for his anointed one.*

**Psalms 46:1**

*God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in time of trouble.*

**Psalms 29:11**

*The LORD gives strength to his people; the LORD blesses his people with peace.*

**Psalms 84:5**

*Blessed are those whose strength is in you, who have set their hearts on pilgrimage.*

**Isaiah 40:29-31**

*He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak. Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall; but those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.*

**Ezekiel 34:16b**

*I will bind up the injured and strengthen the weak.*

**Isaiah 58:11a**

*The LORD will guide you always; he will satisfy your needs in a sun scorched land and will strengthen your frame.*

**Philippians 4:13**

*I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.*
